


## History

Vanuatu is an archipelago

83 islands.

Population 280,000

Six provinces



## Current status

- ∘2016 52 registered midwives
  - approx. 42 were delivering midwifery service delivery

- Average age (retirement age 55yrs)
- •The distribution is uneven
- Tafea Shefa Malampa Panama Samna and Torba -

"Midwifery has been identified as the single most influential cadre to improve maternal health and reduce maternal and neonatal mortality." as mentioned in (Lancet, 2014).

### 2010 VCNE - Registered Training Provider

  - Diminished numbers and
  - Poor access for women




