

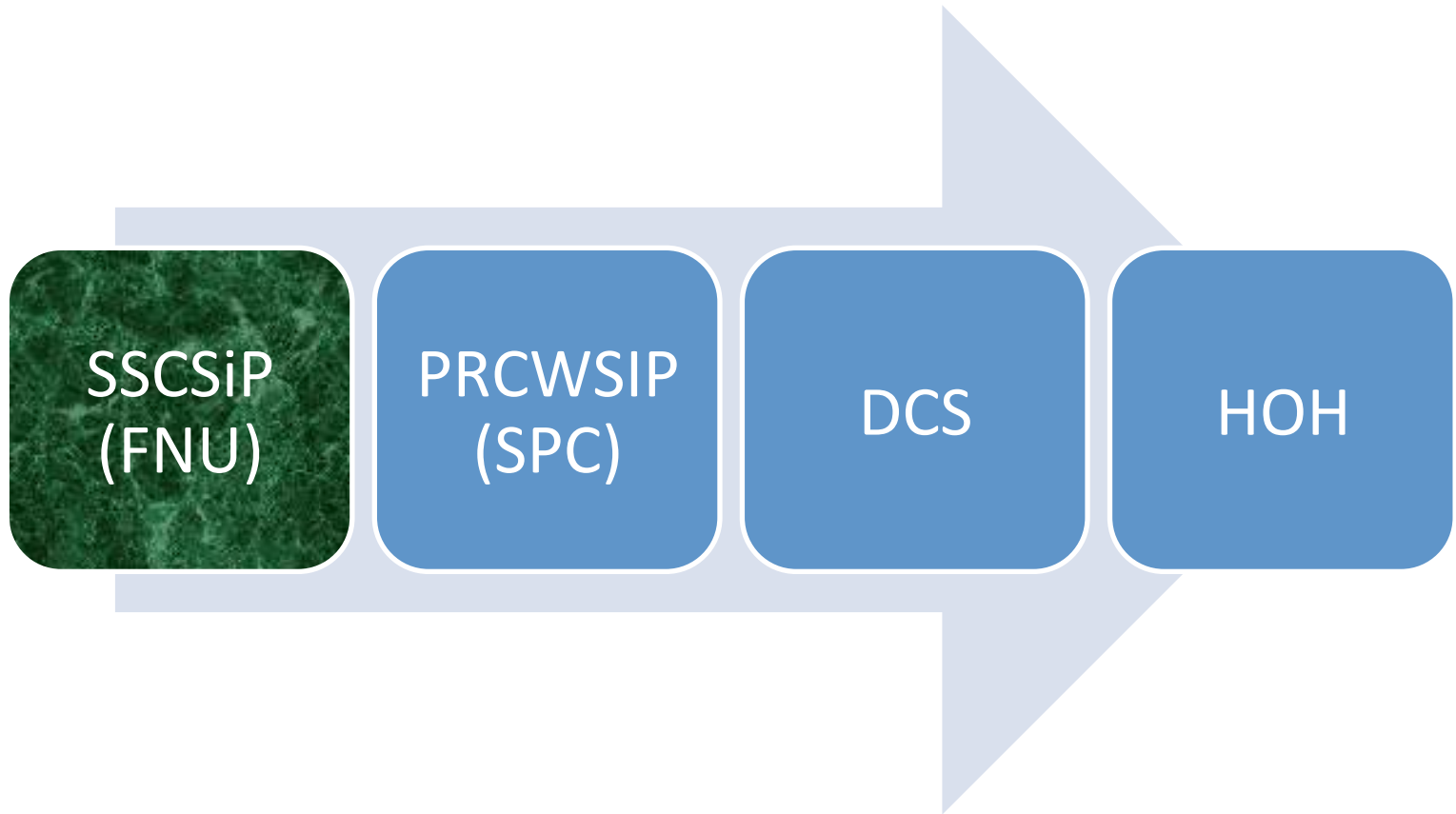

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FNU CMNHS post graduate students are representative of the region, successfully graduate with relevant competency to practice in the Pacific

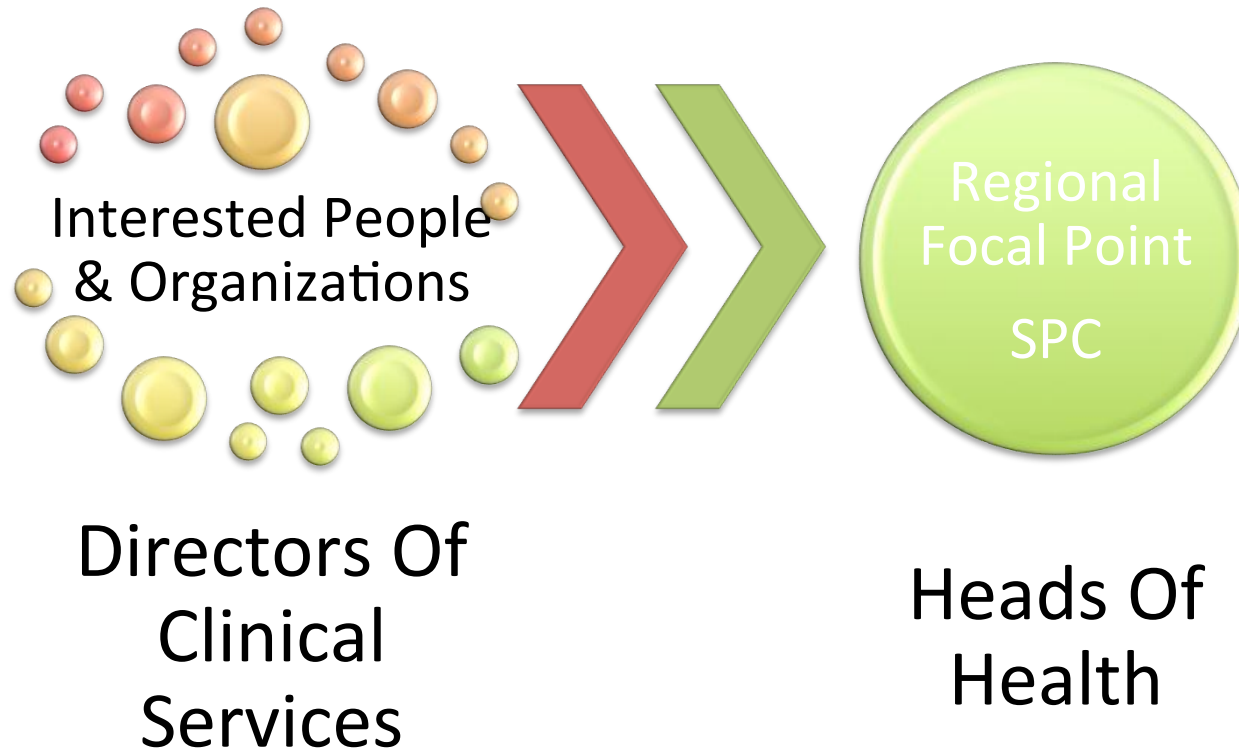
PICs value and actively engage in regional fora on relevant clinical services and health workforce issues

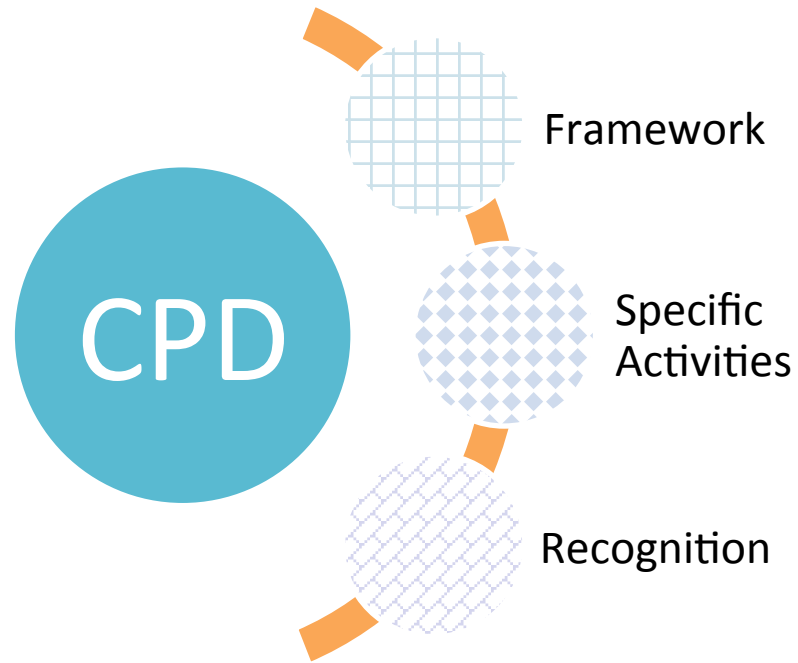
Health Workforce Training

- training providers be more responsive to clinical workforce needs of PICTs and disease profile (Offline POHLN, in-country training)
- standardisation of internship programmes in the region
- support & strengthen Primary Health Care

Health Workforce Training

- Regional PG radiology training be developed by training providers
- recommends that PICTs develop contingency plans for the absence of specialists;
- Recommends continuing support for Biomedical Departments

Continuing Professional Development

- the regional CPD frameworks adapted to country specific needs if needed
- recommends that minimum CPD should be in the area of specialty
- recommends assistance to help to strengthen medical councils;

Nursing Specialisation

- recommends representatives from SPCNMOA to be an integral part DCS
- Recommends that training providers strengthen the provision of specialized nursing
- recommends that PICTs provide clinical nursing career pathways



Offshore medical evacuations / referrals

- recommends strengthening legislation and funding mechanisms (cost sharing with patients, or through the health insurance system)
- recommends producing data on health outcomes for patients
- recommends bringing in specialists and equipment to provide service in-country

Other Key Decision Points

- requests that PICTs cover medical indemnity of volunteers for the period they spend in-country.

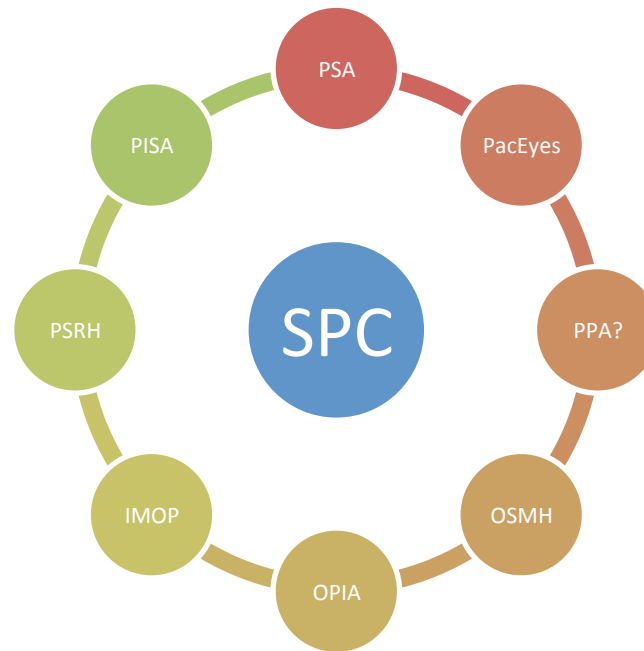
