



## **PSRH 16th Biennial Conference & Pre-Conference Workshops 2026, Tonga**

### **Terms and Conditions of Registration and Attendance**

#### **1. Acceptance of Terms**

By registering for or attending the PSRH 16th Biennial Conference and associated activities, participants agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.

#### **2. Purpose and Nature of the Conference**

The Conference is convened as a professional and educational forum aligned with PSRH's charitable purpose and Strategic Blueprint. Views expressed by presenters are their own and do not constitute endorsement by PSRH.

#### **3. Registration and Eligibility**

Registration is required for all participants. PSRH reserves the right to refuse or revoke registration where conduct is inconsistent with PSRH values or governance standards.

#### **4. Programme Changes**

PSRH may amend the programme due to circumstances beyond its control and is not liable for any resulting loss.

#### **5. Mode of Delivery**

The Conference is planned as an in-person event in Tonga. Any required changes will be communicated promptly.

#### **6. Health, Safety and Wellbeing**

Participants must comply with applicable laws, public health guidance and venue requirements. Attendance is at the participant's own risk.

#### **7. Fees and Payment**

Registration is confirmed only upon receipt of full payment. Administrative and card fees are non-refundable.

#### **8. Cancellation and Refunds**

Cancellation requests must be submitted in writing. Cancellations received on or before July 1 may be eligible for a refund less an administration fee. Cancellations received

after July 1 may not be eligible for a refund. No refunds apply for non-attendance without notice. Exceptional circumstances may be considered at PSRH's discretion.

Participants are responsible for their own visas, travel and insurance. PSRH accepts no liability for related costs.

#### 10. Code of Conduct and Ethical Engagement

Participants must comply with the PSRH Code of Conduct. PSRH supports ethical, transparent engagement with industry aligned with Pacific SRH priorities. PSRH may remove participants for non-compliance without refund.
